

Dear Parents and Coaches of Middleton Youth Soccer U-10 players:

The mission of our program is to provide an environment where our children have fun, learn, and develop a love for the game of soccer. U-10 is where our developmental soccer experience begins to evolve to a game experience. U-10 is defined as a “Non Results Oriented” program by our travel organization, our State, and our MYS organization by participation. This means there is no focus on scores. No league scores are posted. No Tournament Champions are determined. The Middleton Board of Directors believes that our program should provide a consistent, positive, developmental result through our volunteer coaches.

Through our wonderful coaches, we fully believe we can make the soccer experience a positive one for the children in our Middleton Youth Soccer program. We feel that our children will benefit most if we focus on our coaches and help them be confident in their ability to teach.

Building on the positive feedback we had from last spring, MYS will continue to provide coaching support including; a player development weekly curriculum, coaching training sessions, and weekly participation, support, and mentoring for our coaches in our program. This year, we are introducing a new U-10 curriculum. This has been developed to focus on age appropriate player development and transition to competitive soccer. MYS will provide coach clinics to explain and support this approach.
